CYDFI Philippines and CYDF USA, Inc. share a Mission of helping to address and do a Crusade Against Abject Poverty in rural areas, in which the latter provides Grants to implement the **Community Youth Leadership and Empowerment Program** of the former, such as:

1. Community-Based Scholarship Project Model
2. Leadership Training on Social Responsibility
3. Research and Development (R & D)
4. 3-R's Literacy Enhancement and Computer-Video-Graphic Design Projects for "high-risk" youths
5. Replication Advocacy Promotion of CYLEP Model to other rural communities

Phase 2: Priority Development of CYLEP Model in the USA.

Project: Community-Based Scholarship Project in SF Bay Area & across the USA

Target: 5 Fil-Am Youths: Nursing in Philippines & 5 Multi-Ethnic Youths in USA

Qualifications for Fil-Am Youths in SF Bay Area & Across the USA

- (1) needy but deserving talented high school graduate, with good moral character
- (2) highly motivated academically and willing to pursue BS in Nursing in the Philippines
- (3) immigrant and/or US Citizen, fluent in the Pilipino language, a plus.
- (4) Youth/parents/guardian must be willing to sign a **CYLEP Contract**, including that once youth is in the Philippines, s/he will comply with the other requirements under the supervision of the CYDFI Philippines.

Qualifications for Multi-Ethnic Youths in SF Bay Area & Across the USA

- (1) needy but deserving talented high school graduate (2) good moral character, (3) highly motivated academically, (4) parent/youth/guardian must be willing to sign a **CYLEP CONTRACT** to ascertain the success of the Project and (5) must be a US Citizen.

Scholarship Grant, for Fil-Am youths, includes all school-related expenses, i.e. tuition and misc. fees, books/supplies, uniform/shoes, food and lodging, RT airline ticket for Annual Break, personal/travel allowance in the City, access to computer/internet, free broadband calls to family/friends in USA. Whereas the multi-ethnic youths will receive the equivalent value of scholarship grant provided to Fil-Am youths to use for their education in the USA

ADVOCACY STATUS (Collaboration: Fil-Am Organizations)

Phase 3: Priority Development of Satellite Replication Project Model

1. CYDF USA, Inc. will collaborate with different Fil-Am Socio-Civic Organizations in the SF Bay Area and form a partnership to join the Crusade Against Abject Poverty.
2. To establish Satellite Replication Project Model in one rural area of their hometown where the Organization would like to initiate the Community-Based Scholarship Project Model and, in time, can move on to replicate the same said Model to other rural areas of their town.
3. **Terms of Partnership/Collaboration:**
 - CYDF USA, Inc. provides Grants to CYDFI Philippines to legally implement the Community Youth Leadership and Empowerment Program in the Philippines and will provide a **60%** counterpart budget and the collaborating Fil-Am body to take care the remaining **40%** of the total budget to implement the Replication Project Model.
 - Sponsoring Fil-Am Organization will decide which rural area in their town in the Philippines to initially start implementing the CYLEP.

Phase 4: As part of the Mission of CYDF USA, Inc. in helping to address and do a crusade against abject poverty across global spectrum in rural areas, it is envisioned that the advocacy would be initiated to do collaboration with other multi-ethnic communities in the SF Bay Area and across the USA to empower them to look back and help their own people in their home country of origin and may replicate Phase 2 Plan, too.
